Yuletide Bazaar Vendor Guidelines
December 14, 2024

Please read these guidelines thoroughly as they have been updated and changed for our 2024 event season. These guidelines are in place to help ensure that our events start and end smoothly as well as give our vendors the greatest opportunity to be successful.

- You may set up on Saturday starting at 7:30AM.
- If you arrive early, please do not park your vehicle within the barricades. You may unload your vehicle but then your vehicle MUST be off Main St. completely. We want the vendor area to look clean, organized, and presentable to ALL guests. Failure to remove your vehicle will result in applications being denied for future events.
- ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF THE STREET BY 9:30 AM on Saturday morning, when the festival begins (if outdoors)
- There will be a Chamber representative available to assist you at these times.
- Booth spaces are 12 feet by 12 feet outside or an 8' table inside. Most adjoin other booth spaces. Please be considerate of your neighboring vendors and do not take more than your assigned space.
- Vendors are responsible for their own displays, booth set up and removal. Food vendors must follow health regulations and laws, and have appropriate health permits.
- All vendors need appropriate resale certificates.
- Because there are few electrical connections on site, plan on providing your own power source, if needed.
- All vendors are responsible for clean-up of rented spaces following the event. We will provide dumpsters for any garbage, use them. Please do not bring any animals to the event.
- The Yuletide Bazaar officially begins on Saturday at 10AM and ends at 4PM. As a courtesy to our buyers, we ask vendors to be available to do business during those hours.
- There is no outside security during this event.
- There will be no refunds for cancellations made within 7 days of the event unless the event is canceled due to inclement weather but we do have plans to move inside if weather conditions permit it.
- Since this is a family event, items for sale, display, education, demonstration, or entertainment must be family-friendly and illegal or explicit items are not allowed.
- If outside, porta- potties will be provided by the Chamber.

- The Chamber of Commerce cannot be responsible for loss including theft, injury, property damage, vandalism, or weather. The space holder assumes full responsibility for his/her space including all items for sale and agrees to hold harmless the McCloud Chamber of Commerce.
